The Arts District has been a thirty-year plan in the making and now boasts buildings by four Pritzker Prize-winning architects within a span of several blocks. The District's architectural richness extends beyond that, however, with from the turn of the 19th century when the neighborhood was the poshest residential district in town on one end and a vibrant African-American settlement on the other. The tour is led by a trained tour guide and will examine buildings from the 1890's to the present day. You will explore the architectural detail of the District as well as the institutions, individuals and visionaries who are a part of this fascinating story.
