<p>Education Work with programs subcommittee to plan at least one annual Luncheon focused on a timely Education topic. Collaborate with ULI management team committee and staff to exchange insights and best practices. <p>Golf Tournament Plan ULI annual golf tournament fundraiser to support outreach activities of ULI San Antonio. Responsibilities include sponsorship, marketing, event coordination, managing budget and reporting to Management Committee. <p>Membership and Outreach Build the diverse and actively involved membership body crucial to support the ULI Mission. Create, implement and evaluate effectiveness of member recruitment and retention. Initiate alliances with strategically aligned organizations to expand ULI's reach and effectiveness. Meeting Commitment: <i>Meet monthly to review progress toward achieving measurable membership goals, contact new members to welcome them, plan outreach events, evaluate and devise new strategies accordingly.</i></p>	<input type="checkbox"/>
<p>November Event: Luncheon & Conference Work with the programs committee to plan this first annual one-day lunch and conference event: finalize topics and program content, solicit and secure sponsorships, obtain keynote speaker and panelists, help promote the event locally, and assist the day of the event as needed. <p>Programs Identify, contact, and schedule engaging speakers on relevant topics for Quarterly Luncheons. Create new programs consistent with the ULI brand and mission, which also form the backbone of all ULI activities. As needed, develop new programs to promote membership, such as Members-only events, and sponsorship through new signature events. Meeting Commitment: <i>Meet monthly to plan future programs and review performance of past programs. Maintain program calendar 6 months in advance.</i></p>	<input type="checkbox"/>
<p>Sponsorship and Finance Conduct Annual Sponsorship campaign to support programming and outreach activities of ULI San Antonio. Work with other committee chairs to increase funding for their initiatives and to manage multiple sponsorship solicitations of key sponsors. Advise and provide financial oversight to Executive Director and Chair, assisting them in maintaining a sound financial basis for achieving District Council mission, goals and objectives. Meeting Commitment: <i>Monthly during period leading up to and during Annual Sponsorship campaign (April-July); quarterly for the rest of the year.</i></p>	<input type="checkbox"/>
<p>Young Leaders Plan monthly programs for ULI Young Leaders (ULI members under 35), and devise other programs or initiatives of interest to the YL group. Identify committee service opportunities in each of the other ULI Leadership Committees for YL Members, and assist in populating those committees with YLs. Meeting Commitment: <i>Meet quarterly to plan programming; each member will be responsible for helping/planning at least one event per year.
